DURING ADMISSION TIME

1. SSC / Intermediate / Degree Original Marks Certificates should be submitted at the time of admission along with 2 passport size photos.
2. The original marks certificates will be returned only on completion of the course.
3. Original Transfer Certificate should be produced at the time of admission, which will not be returned under any circumstances.
4. Migration Certificate while appearing for interview for either intermediate or Degree courses.

ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATE

All the candidates from other states as well as those who appeared for examination under Boards other than SSC Board of Andhra Pradesh are required to obtain eligibility certificate from the Regional Inspection Officer (RIO), Board of Intermediate Education.

RELIGION CERTIFICATE

The Christian minority candidates are required to produce the religion certificate issued by Parish Priest for Catholics and pastor for other Christian students.

CASTE CERTIFICATE

- i. Applicable to candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Backward Classes. This certificate must be issued by Mandal Revenue Officer.
- ii. Foreign students should produce a regular long term student visa issued by an Indian Embassy Abroad.
