

ANNUAL REPORT 2023-24

As yet another academic year draws to a close, it is my privilege to present to you an account of our progress, achievements, aspirations and challenges as I read to you the 62nd annual report of Maris Stella College.

College re-opened for the second and third year undergraduates on 3rd July, for Intermediate students on the 1st June and for the Post-Graduates on 12th June, 2023. A student Induction Programme was initiated on 19th June 2023 for the fresh undergraduate students. An orientation programme was organised on 5th August, 2023 for the new faculty.

New appointments have been made at the college, resulting in significant changes in leadership and administrative roles.

Results:

The Intermediate pass percentage was 65. Degree programmes registered the following results: B.A. 90%, B. Com. 74%, BBM 94% and B.Sc. 91%. All the PG programmes secured cent per cent results.

Highlights of the Academic Year:

For the first time, Maris Stella introduced French as a second language for undergraduate students starting from the academic year 2023-24. Sixty-three UG students are pursuing the subject at present.

The college was awarded a certificate of merit for creating awareness on social issues by the NTR District Collector, Sri Dilli Rao, on Republic Day, 26th January, 2024.

The Week Hans Survey on the best colleges of India ranked the UG programmes for the year 2023: Arts 51, Sciences 54 and Commerce 89.

The college was granted autonomous status for PG programs from the academic year 2023-24 by Krishna University, Machilipatnam.

Anjali from III B.Com. Computers represented Krishna University in a virtual interaction with the honorable Chief Minister, marking a proud moment for the college.

Tejasree from III B.com. Computers was selected as one of the first participants to subscribe to edX in the presence of the honorable Chief Minister.

College premises were utilised for the Government Teachers Training in October 2023 and the Elections Training of Magistrates and Tahasildars in February 2024.

Grants

The college was selected for the prestigious US Department of State-sponsored English Access Microscholarship program for 55 underserved students from their third to sixth semesters. We are deeply grateful to US Consul General Jennifer Larson.

Under the RUSA 2.0 scheme, a new academic block was inaugurated on 13th November 2023, by Dr. Pola Bhaskar, IAS, Commissioner of Collegiate & Technical Education and State Project Director of RUSA, AP. A computer lab has been equipped with 45 new computers under MPLAD Scheme extended generously by Sri Kesineni Srinivas (Nani), Member of Parliament, Vijayawada Constituency which was inaugurated on 12th March 2024. We express our profound gratitude to Sri Kesineni Nani.

In collaboration with Care to Action, India, the college initiated an English Language Bridge course for first-semester UG students and a Power Skills Programme, a subject-specific skill training

programme for fifth-semester UG students in view of enhancing employment opportunities. Maris Stella profusely thanks Mr. Antonio, the Director.

The college received a grant of 10,000 US Dollars towards Service Learning for two years from the United Board, an international NGO committed to whole person education.

The Cambridge English Language certificate was introduced for advanced learners of UG courses in the Odd Semester.
